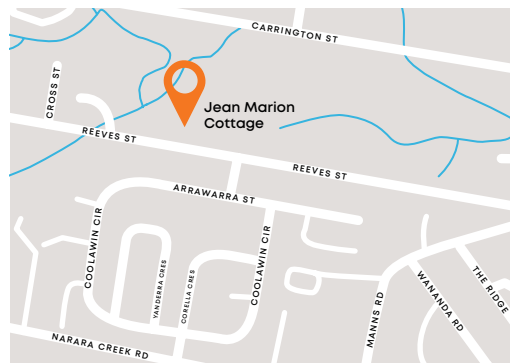

How does it work?

Who is eligible?

This service is available to people living in the Central Coast area who are primary carers of frail older people, including people living with dementia. Please see details on the back of this brochure to contact our service manager for details on how to apply.

What does it cost?

Fees are negotiable and can be discussed with the service manager. No carer would be discriminated against because of their inability to pay.
