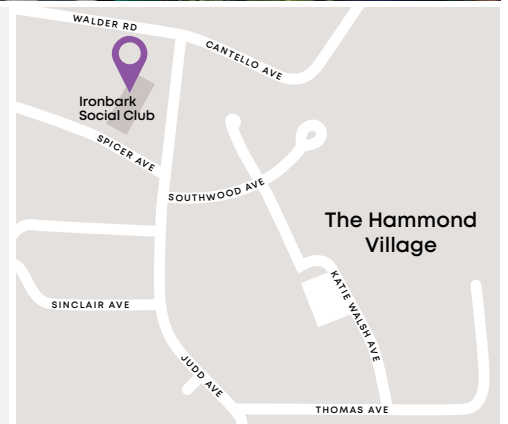
How can I access this service?
